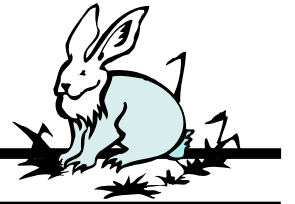

## Easter Egg Hunt



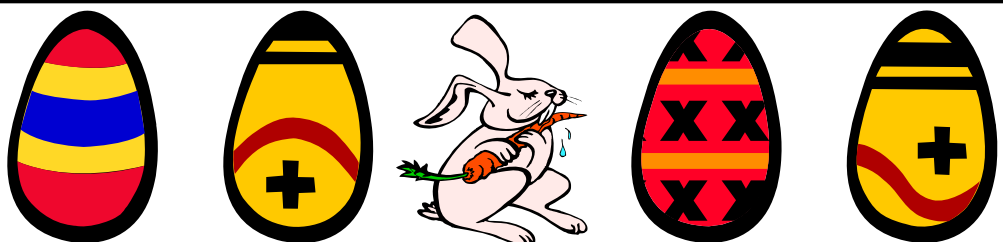
